Clifford J. Ruddle D.D.S., F.A.C.D., F.I.C.D. CREATING ENDODONTIC EXCELLENCE

Dr. Clifford J. Ruddle is the founder and director of Advanced Endodontic Seminars, an international teaching center in Santa Barbara, California. He received his dental degree from the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry, San Francisco, California, and completed his post-graduate work in endodontics at Harvard School of Dental Medicine, Boston, Massachusetts. Dr. Ruddle is a fellow in both the American and International Colleges of Dentistry, is an Assistant Professor of Graduate Endodontics at Loma Linda University and University of California, Los Angeles, and is a consultant to the Long Beach Veterans Medical Center. Dr. Ruddle is an international lecturer in all aspects of endodontics and has contributed widely to endodontic textbooks and journals and maintains a private practice in Santa Barbara, California.

Dr. Ruddle will speak on endodontic excellence and how to create it. Endodontic concepts, technology, and techniques have dramatically advanced in recent years, which have left many clinicians in the gap between where they are and what is possible. This presentation will address the critically essential elements of success, including diagnosis, root canal system anatomy, access cavities, irrigants, working length, new instrument designs, cleaning and shaping strategies, and vertical condensation of warm gutta percha. The objectives of this presentation are to close the endodontic gap, create breakthrough training, and generate a future that expands ability, efficiency, and personal satisfaction.

Tulsa Dental Products/Dentsply International THE PROFILE ENDODONTIC SYSTEM WORKSHOP

This participation workshop will be an introduction to the PROFILE Series 29 nickel titanium rotary endodontic instruments. Both the .04 and .06 taper instruments are used in a controlled, high torque slow speed rotary handpiece. This results in a quicker, centered, tapered preparation, while maintaining good tactile sense. As the instrument is moved apically, it planes the walls of the canal, smoothing them and making them circular, as well as moving the canal debris up and out of the preparation. This reaming action in conjunction with the non-standard double taper shaft (Series 29), produces a "crown down" preparation resulting in a funnel form taper from orifice to apex - quick and efficiently.

Dr. med. dent. Burkhardt Gieloff IMMEDIATE AND INDIVIDUAL IMPLANTS WITH THE RE-IMPLANT® SYSTEM

Born in 1952, Dr. Gieloff studied tooth medicine at the University of Freiburg, where he graduated magna cum laude with a degree in dentistry in 1978.

Dr. Gieloff did his residency during 1978-1982 while also serving as a dentist in the German military during 1981-1982. In 1982, Dr. Gieloff opened his practice specializing in implantology. Since 1984 he has been lecturing internationally on various subjects relating to implantology.

Dr. Gieloff will discuss the RE-IMPLANT® System, which involves taking an extracted tooth, preparing it for cad-cam reproduction in titanium and re-implanting the titanium model into the fresh extraction site. Dr. Gieloff was involved in the research and development of this newly patented system in Germany.
